Our Dr. Andy Anderson Young Professional Award is a yearly award presented to one professional per province that best epitomizes exemplary work on behalf of the physical and health education profession. Selection of the award recipient is made by a PHE Canada representative in each province or territory.

Eligibility: The candidate must be a member of PHE Canada or a Liaison Group, and be 35 years of age or less, although some exceptions can be made for individuals who started late-entry careers.

At the January 2008 Board of Directors meeting, a motion was passed to rename the PHE Canada Young Professional Award the Dr. Andy Anderson Young Professional Award.

Andy was an incredible leader and had an enormous impact on the field of health and physical education. The Dr. Andy Anderson Young Professional Award will help to further recognize his significant contribution to the field.
